CHARITABLE/NONPROFIT VEHICLE

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATION

*** READ INFORMATION ON BACK BEFORE FILLING OUT THIS FORM ***

I certify this motor vehicle will be used exclusively as described in ORS 825.015 or ORS 825.017 (14) and specifically that:

1. This vehicle is either:
 - a. A vehicle with a seating capacity of fewer than 16 persons and used exclusively for commuting to job, job training, or educational facilities; OR
 - b. A vehicle owned, operated or under contract with a charitable organization and used exclusively in performing transportation necessary to the operation of that organization; AND
2. If Item **1(b)** applies, an affidavit is on file with the Motor Carrier Transportation Division; AND
3. The vehicle will be used exclusively as described in Number 1 above, and if this vehicle is ever to be used for any other purpose, I will first surrender the charitable/nonprofit registration plates to the division; AND
4. If this vehicle is sold to someone who does not qualify for this type of registration, I will remove the plates from the vehicle.

I UNDERSTAND IT IS A CRIME UNDER ORS 162.085 TO CERTIFY THE TRUTH OF A STATEMENT WHEN I KNOW THE STATEMENT IS NOT TRUE. SUCH A CRIME IS PUNISHABLE BY A JAIL SENTENCE OF UP TO SIX MONTHS, A FINE OF \$2,500, OR BOTH.

NONPROFIT VEHICLES are vehicles “with a seating capacity of fewer than 16 persons and are used in nonprofit operation for commuting to job, job training or educational facilities. ‘Nonprofit operation’ means a voluntary commuter ride-sharing arrangement that may charge a fee to defray expenses, but remains nonprofit in its operation without reference to any entity that may sponsor it.” ORS 825.015.

CHARITABLE VEHICLES are vehicles owned, operated by, or under contract with, a charitable organization, and are used exclusively “in performing transportation, either one-way or round trip, necessary to the operation of the charitable organization.”

CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION means an organization that “has no capital stock and no provision for making dividends or profits, but derives its funds principally from public and private charity and holds them in trust for the promotion of the welfare of others and not for profit.” ORS 825.017 (14)
