Grounds for Immediate Failure

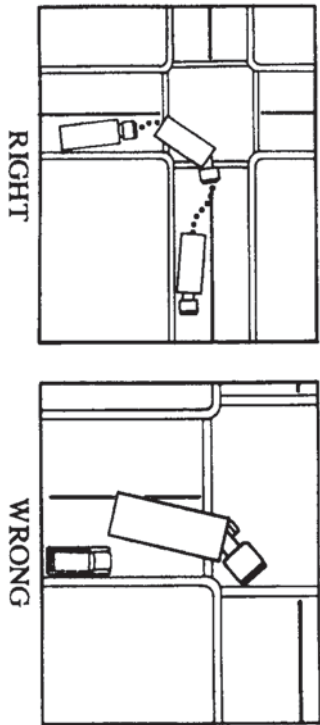
1. An accident involving any amount of property damage or personal injury.
2. The applicant refuses to perform any maneuver which is part of the prescribed skills test.
3. Any dangerous action which:
 - a. An accident is prevented by expert driving or action on the part of other drivers.
 - b. The examiner is forced to assist the driver in avoiding an accident physically or orally.
 - c. The applicant drives over curb or sidewalk in a way that is potentially dangerous to property or pedestrians.
 - d. By stalling or other improper driving behavior, the applicant creates a serious traffic hazard.
4. The applicant commits any of the following:
 - a. Passes another car which is stopped at a crosswalk yielding to a pedestrian, or passes a school bus stopped with its red lights flashing.
 - b. Makes or starts to make one turn from the wrong lane under traffic conditions that render such actions **dangerous**.
 - c. Runs through or has to be stopped from running one red light or one stop sign.
5. Applicant is unable to properly operate vehicle equipment, or after proceeding a short distance on the drive course, it becomes apparent that the applicant is dangerously inexperienced.

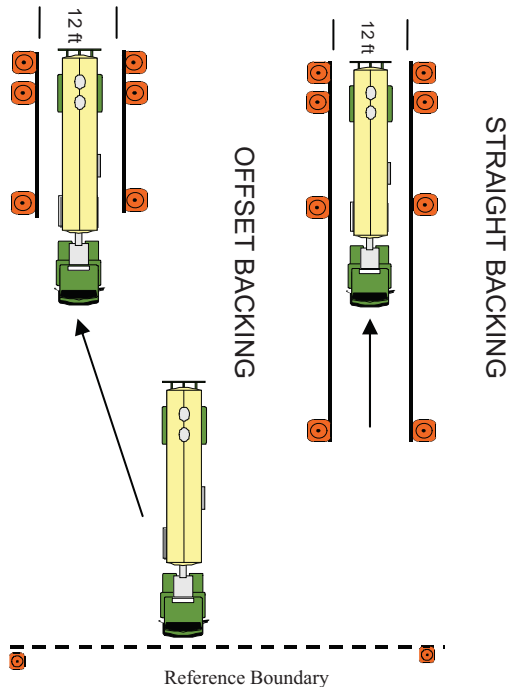

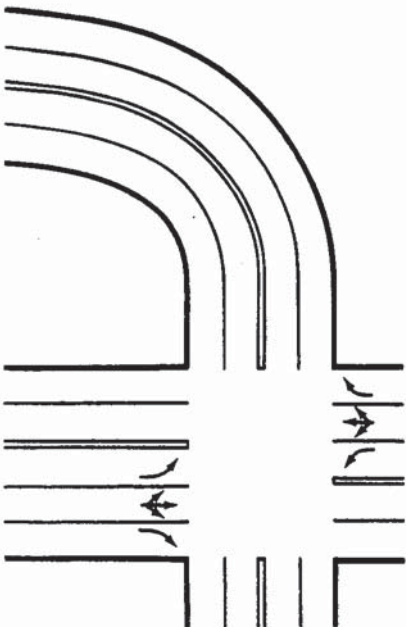


TRACTOR - TRAILER

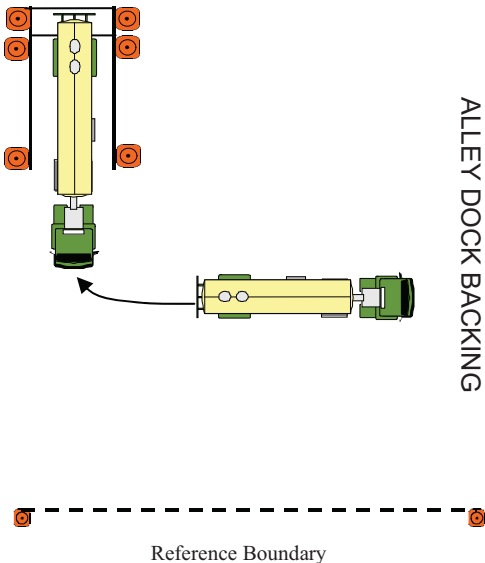


STRAIGHT BACKING

The test you are about to take is the last and perhaps the most important part of your commercial driver license examination. It gives you a chance to show how you drive in traffic and how you control your vehicle during the skills test.

You do not have to be a perfect driver to pass. We know you are probably nervous. Your examiner will try to help you get over any nervousness or tension before you start driving.

Your examiner will not talk or visit with you during the test, except to give you instructions. That way you can keep your mind on your driving. Your examiner will talk to you about your driving, or any mistakes you make, when the test is over. If you have any questions about the test, please ask before the test starts. You may also ask questions about your test after you return to the starting point. No tricks are used during the test. You will not be asked to do anything that is against the law, nor anything that is not a part of driving in today's traffic.

During the driving test, the examiner will make notes on the test score sheet. The key maneuvers that will be observed during the test are listed inside this pamphlet.

For the test to be conducted, the vehicle you are driving must be in safe operating condition. The vehicle must be covered by liability insurance. You, the driver, must carry a valid medical card.

There are three parts to this test, the pre-trip vehicle inspection test, the basic control skills test, and the drive test. Your examiner will ask you to inspect the equipment items listed on the Pre-Trip Inspection Criteria Form. You will walk around the vehicle and point to or touch each item and explain to the examiner what you are checking and why. You must perform this test in the order listed on the form. The examiner will provide you with a copy of the form to be used during the test.

PLEASE DO NOT SMOKE DURING THE TEST
