Remember, you must order Temporary Registration Permits through DMV Business License Unit, **not** through ODOT Storeroom.

ADVERTISING ISSUES

DMV Investigators are frequently contacted regarding advertising requirements. Although the Oregon Department of Justice enforces this rule (not DMV), we still want to insure that dealers are aware of the regulations regarding their advertisements.

The regulations require dealers to put in the complete business name which indicates that you are a dealer of vehicles; the word "dealer" or the abbreviation "DLR." "Broker" or "Private Dealer" are not acceptable (Oregon Administrative Rule 137-020-0050(2)(j)).

ODOT STOREROOM ORDERING TIPS

1. Determine list of forms needed.
2. Review preface of Title and Registration Handbook to see if item/form is available through ODOT Storeroom (Examples include but are not limited to Temporary Registration Permits, Form 315, Dealer Trip Permits, Form 306, which are available from DMV Business Licensing Unit).
3. Complete the Request for Forms to be Mailed, Form 6110, or compose a letter with the form name and number.
4. Mail the letter or Form 6110 to:

NOTE: You can order the Secure Power of Attorney, Form 402 and Secure Odometer Disclosure/Reassignment, Form 403, from either the Oregon Automobile Dealer's Association or Oregon Independent Auto Dealer's Association. The ODOT Storeroom and DMV will not supply these forms to dealers, lenders, or other bulk users, such as banks.

PLATE MANUFACTURING FEE DECREASE

Effective July 1, 2003, DMV's plate manufacturing fee will decrease by \$.50. The fee is charged anytime plates are issued and reflects the actual cost to manufacture the plates.

Dealer transactions with a date of sale before July 1, 2003 need to include the old plate manufacturing fee (\$2.00 for one plate, \$3.00 for a set of two plates). Dealer transactions with a date of sale of July 1, 2003 and later should include the new, lower fee (\$1.50 for one plate, \$2.50 for a set of plates). Beginning August 1, 2003, all dealer transactions must include the new, lower plate fees regardless of when the transaction occurred at the dealership.

The following fees reflect the decrease:

Dealer Plates (Effective July 1, 2003):

Original and additional dealer plates—\$43.50

Motorcycle/Moped, Snowmobile,
Class I/III ATV \$10.50

Original issue plate fees (in addition to any applicable surcharge and registration fees):

Vehicles requiring one plate - \$1.50
Vehicles requiring two plates - \$2.50

Replacement plate fees (in addition to any applicable surcharge and registration fees):

At renewal:

Vehicles requiring one plate - \$6.50
Vehicles requiring two plates - \$7.50

Between renewals:

Vehicles requiring one plate - \$11.50
Vehicles requiring two plates - \$12.50
